## **HUNGER PREVENTION & NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (HPNAP) & Nourish NY** 2026-2027 Borough-Wide Application Overview

### **What you need to know to apply for the HPNAP & Nourish NY Food and Operations Support grant:**

- **Application will be available on Monday, April 13, 2026**
- **Application Due Date is Friday, May 15, 2026**
- Funding Period is July 1, 2026– June 30, 2027
- The application will be available on your agency's FeedNYC EFP portal page. (Note: this is the website where you enter monthly service statistics)
- If you do not have an active FeedNYC account, you will be required to create a user login (see Instruction Booklet for details).
- The Online Application Instruction Booklet, that is posted on the FEEDNYC.org home page and linked on the application, references all application criteria and instructions.
- You can only apply online at <https://www.FeedNYC.org> .
- Informational webinars will be offered to all applicants. We strongly suggest that you attend one session.
- **Note:** Operations Support is administered by United Way of New York City in a reimbursement payment structure. Organizations will be required to submit eligible supporting documentation for certain non-food cost purchases incurred during the grant period to receive funding.

### **Who is eligible to apply?**

A full list of eligibility criteria is available in the Online Application Instruction Booklet.

- Soup Kitchens and Food Pantries with existing funding resources in operation for **at least 6** consecutive months, serving **no fewer** than 100 people per month, providing emergency food services and open to the general public.
- Must be a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt non-profit organization and have a list of current Board of Directors with individual contact information. Organizational contact information is **not sufficient** for the Board of Directors.
- For Soup Kitchens ONLY: Must have a current New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Food Service Establishment Permit or a copy of the submitted application.

### **What do you need to complete your application?**

- Go to <https://www.FeedNYC.org/> and log in to your agency's FeedNYC EFP portal.
- Please have access to the following information before beginning the application process.
  - Electronic copies of 501(c)(3) letter, Board of Directors list, DOH Soup Kitchen permit (if applicable) and lease agreement (if applicable).
  - Employer Identification Number (EIN).
  - Email address that can be accessed by the applicant.
  - Email address of the Executive Director, President or Religious Leader of your organization.
  - All contact information for person(s) responsible for your food program.
